HENDRICKS COUNTY TOURISM COMMISSION WELCOMES NEW MEMBER

Other Commission members include Jill Aichinger of Danville and Beasley’s Orchard, Jennifer Smith of Danville, Director of Sales for the Staybridge Suites and the Holiday Inn Express both located in Plainfield and Janet Hicks of Avon.

The Commission includes nine members of the tourism community and all must be residents of the county. Seven of the nine members are appointed by the County Commissioners, and the Town of Plainfield appoints two of the members in accordance with the Indiana state statute.
